How many trees will be removed?

- A total of 201 trees are proposed to be removed in the project area.
 - 147 of the 201 total trees are proposed to be removed *entirely* to allow for construction.
 - 54 of the 201 total trees are proposed to be removed *partially*. These 54 trees have been deemed hazardous trees. However, because they are not directly in the construction area, their stumps can be left in place to lessen environmental impacts.

What species are they, and how many of each species will be removed?

How many trees will be planted?

- A total of 462 trees are proposed to be planted in the project area.
 - 402 of the total trees will measure at least 4 feet tall and come from 5-gallon containers.
 - This number (402) reflects double the number of trees proposed for removal, per the City of Camas Tree Ordinance.
 - In addition, 60 seedling trees are proposed to be planted within more sensitive areas.

What species are they, and how many of each species will be planted?

- Of the 402 container trees proposed to be planted:
 - 242 (60%) are Douglas Fir
 - 120 (30%) are Western Red Cedars
 - 40 (10%) are Big Leaf Maples
- Of the 60 seedling trees proposed to be planted:
 - 30 (60%) are Douglas Fir
 - 20 (30%) are Western Red Cedars
 - 10 (10%) are Big Leaf Maples
