RESCISSION OF ADMINISTRATIVE
ORDER RE MASK REQUIREMENTS
FOR COURTHOUSE
NO. GAO 2021-12

WHEREAS the Center for Disease Control recently issued updated guidance for wearing masks based on COVID19 community levels.

WHEREAS Clark County Washington is currently identified as a medium community level according to the CDC which does not requires wearing a mask indoors.

WHEREAS the current Washington Department of Health mask guidance provides effective March 12. 2022, face masks will no longer be required in many indoor settings.

WHEREAS Superior and District Court have obtained guidance from Dr. Alan Menick, Clark County Public Health Director and Clark County Health Officer.

1 THEREFORE, it is hereby Ordered that effective Monday, March 14, 2022:

2 1. All persons in the Clark County and Camas/Washougal Municipal Courthouses
3 including the Probation/Pretrial and Community Restitution divisions shall no longer be
4 required to wear a mask while in the public areas in the building. Anybody entering
5 buildings housing these divisions may choose to wear a mask at any time. Those who
6 are immunosuppressed are encouraged to always wear a mask.
7

8 2. All persons in a county transportation vehicle utilized for Community Restitution
9 will still be required to wear a mask while in transport consistent with State and Federal
10 guidelines until said guidelines are lifted.
11

12 3. With the exception noted above, all provisions relating to masking requirements
13 in previous orders are hereby rescinded. Any other provisions not addressed in this
14 administrative order remain in full effect.
