

## NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PUBLIC HEARING DISCOVER RECOVERY (FILE NO. CUP21-01)

An application from Discover Recovery was received on January 21, 2021 and deemed technically complete on February 12, 2021. The applicant requests approval of a Conditional Use Permit for a 15-bed convalescent home that will be located at 2213 NW 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Camas, WA. According to Camas Municipal Code (CMC): "*Nursing, rest or convalescent home*" means an establishment which provides full-time care for three or more chronically ill or infirm persons. Such care shall not include surgical, obstetrical, or acute illness services" -- CMC18.03.030.

The standards for evaluating a Conditional Use Permit are at Camas Municipal Code (CMC), Chapter 18.43 Conditional Use Permits. Conditional Use Permits require a public hearing and final decision by the hearings examiner as it is a Type III permit. Information on this permit type can be found online at the city's website (<u>Type III</u> and <u>CUP</u>). A staff report will be made available a week prior to the public hearing. **Public Hearing**: A virtual public hearing will be held before the city's hearings examiner on **March 24**, **2021 at 5:00 p.m.**, using the Zoom Application. *Comment Period*: The city must receive mailed or emailed comments prior to **5:00 p.m. on March 16**, **2021**, in order for the comments to be added to the record that is provided in advance to the hearings examiner.

*Participate*: Public comments and questions are encouraged, and there are several opportunities available to interested citizens. It is preferable that written comments be received one week prior to the public hearing, in order to be available with the online agenda and materials.
