



Camas – Washougal Fire Marshal’s Office

Permit Application (Rev 06/12/23)

The CWFD Fire Marshal’s Office conducts plan reviews, issues permits and performs inspections for fire code compliance in multiple projects/situations including but not limited to:

- 1) Buildings - new construction, alterations or change in use (tenant improvement)
- 2) Installation or alteration of fire and life safety systems
- 3) Maintenance, use, storage, or handling of hazardous materials
- 4) Processes which produce conditions hazardous to life or property and/or the installation of equipment used in connection with such activities.

Permit Applications shall be submitted to the Fire Marshal’s Office accompanied by a brief narrative describing the project, two (2) sets of plans and specifications and any other information as may be necessary to determine compliance with fire and life safety codes and standards.

Applications may be made Monday - Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at one of the following locations:

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Fire Alarm Submittal Requirements*: All fire alarm drawings are required to be stamped by a Fire Protection Engineer or a person with a minimum of NICET (or equivalent) Level III certification.

Fire Alarm Installation*: Fire alarm systems shall be installed by an electrician properly certified by the State of Washington or under the direct supervision of individuals that have factory training and certification on the system being installed or NICET (or equivalent) Fire Protection-Fire Alarm Level II certification. Fire alarm systems shall be maintained and tested in accordance with municipal codes by persons under the direct supervision of individuals that have factory training and certification on the system being maintained or NICET (or equivalent) Fire Protection-Fire Alarm Level II certification.

Automatic Fire Sprinkler Submittal Requirements**: All fire sprinkler drawings shall be stamped by a person with the appropriate level license issued by the Washington State Fire Protection Bureau.

Residential 13D application submittals are to be accompanied by a contractor submittal form and cut sheets. Drawings are not required. Those unfamiliar with the process/requirements are encouraged to contact the Fire Marshal prior to submitting to ensure that all criteria are met and to avoid re-inspection fees.

Blasting Permit Requirement: Per Camas/Washougal Municipal Code: “The permittee shall defend, indemnify, and hold the city, its officers, officials, employees, and volunteers harmless from any and all claims, injuries, damages, losses, or suits, including attorney fees arising out of in conjunction with activities or operations performed by the permittee or on the permittee’s behalf out of the issuance of this permit, including the procurement of adequate insurance as required by the city, except for injuries and damages caused by the sole negligence of the city.”

Each additional inspection for these permit types will incur an additional fee per the schedule.
