The City of Camas is seeking a Utilities Manager. This is an exempt, non-represented position and is eligible for a full benefits package including paid time off and paid administrative leave.

This position will report to the Public Works Director and will direct, manage, and supervise operations and professional staff assigned to the water, sewer, stormwater and solid waste utilities (Utilities Section) under the Department of Public Works. This position will also coordinate the budget, long-range planning activities, and be responsible for the regulatory compliance of the Section. This position, in coordination with other departments, develops, implements, oversees, and reviews plans and programs associated with the City's utility systems. The Utilities Manager may, at the Director's discretion, assume overall management of the Department when the Director is absent.

The ideal candidate shall possess:

- Education equivalent to a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university with major course work in engineering or a related field
- Five years of increasingly responsible experience in the areas of water, sewer, stormwater, wastewater or a related field, and construction management as they apply to this position
- At least three full years of public works related administrative, management and supervisory responsibility
- Active registration as a Professional Engineer in the state of Washington or ability to obtain a license through reciprocity within six months of employment
- Valid driver's license

In addition to the job description requirements, the preferred candidate will possess the following attributes: excellent interpersonal skills, excellent verbal and written communication skills, demonstrated organizational and decision making skills, ability to work with all sectors of the community - public, private, business, schools, and citizens, ability to be a strong team player and flexibility to work non-standard hours as needed.
