

Volunteer and Sponsorship Opportunities

All of the City of Camas' Parks and Recreation Special Events continue to be offered free of charge to our community due to the support of our Camas City Council, our volunteers, and the support of our sponsors. Easter Egg Hunt



The Easter Day Egg Hunt is held on Easter Sunday. Children, ages 2 to 9, gather in five different age groups to hunt for thousands of eggs filled with candy, toys, and prize tokens. Over 10,000 plastic eggs are filled by volunteers during a special egg-stuffing party. Sponsorship commitment is needed by December 1 (if Easter takes place in March) or by February 1 (if Easter takes place in April.)

Camtown Youth Festival



The Camtown Youth Festival offers a variety of games and interactive amusements, arts & crafts activities, entertainment, food, dunk tank, a petting zoo, art show, a kids' flea & craft market, and youth information tables. It is held the first Saturday of June. Camas School District students vote on the festival elements included in the event. Over 100 volunteers are needed to run the event. Attendance averages around 2,500 people during good weather. Sponsorship commitment is needed by April 1.

Camas Days Kids' Parade



The Kids' Parade is held on the Friday of the Camas Days community celebration. It features costume contests, parade-themed toys for each participant, and a four block parade route - and, it's just for kids! Typically, around 20 volunteers are used to make this event move! Sponsorship commitment is needed by May 1.

Concerts in the Park



Concerts in the Park are held every Thursday evening beginning the week of Camas Days in July. Each year, concert attendees fill out a survey choosing the styles of music to be played the following year. Attendance ranges from 300 to 800 during good weather. Sponsorship commitment is needed by May 1.

Movies in the Park



Movies rated G and PG are played in Crown Park on Fridays during the month of August. Pre-event activities are held before each movie. Attendance ranges from between 200 to 500 movie-goers each Friday. Sponsorship commitment is needed by May 1.

Family Halloween Night



This popular Fall event occurs the Saturday before Halloween in one of the Camas School District gymnasiums. Family Halloween Night offers a variety of Autumn crafts, photo booth, carnival games with candy and prizes, inflatable games and the popular costume contest. Over 500 attendees are requested to enter with two canned goods or 1 new toy to benefit our local community charity, Treasure House. Over 40 volunteers are encouraged each year to participate. Sponsorship commitment is needed by August 1.

Hometown Holidays



Over 2,500 people gather for this annual holiday event featuring the tree lighting, Santa Claus, arts & crafts activities, school bands and choirs, local entertainment, hay rides, and food & refreshments - all in the historic Downtown Camas. Restaurants and businesses remain open late for this special event. Over 35 volunteers help the event run smoothly. Sponsorship commitment is needed by September 1.
