The City also proposes to adopt a Comprehensive Stormwater Drainage Plan. All of the proposed amendments were recommended for approval at individual public hearings before the Planning Commission. A decision on the consolidated amendments is pending. The map amendments, along with corrections to minor mapping errors, are displayed on a draft "Camas"

Comprehensive Plan" map and a draft "Camas Zoning" map, which are available for review.

It was moved by Troy Hull, seconded by David Shepherd to forward a recommendation of approval to City Council for the Rose Property Comprehensive Plan Amendments for parcel numbers 175721-000 and 175774-000. The motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.

It was moved by Tim Hein, seconded by David Shepherd to forward a recommendation of approval to City Council to correct the inadvertent mapping errors as outlined on page 6 in the staff report. The motion carried unanimously by roll call vote.
